- 3 Peace Poles: Presented by the Japanese Government. "May Peace Prevail"
- 4 Historical Interpretive
 Center: Under construction.
 Restrooms open.
- 5 Interpretive Centre & Conservatory: thousands of succulents and cacti, restaurant, gift shop and horticulture library

- 6 Sunken Garden Area: Fountain pool and landscaped with thousands of plants
- 7 Carillon Bell Tower: A 1976 Bi-Centennial project of The ND Veterans' Organization
- 8 911 Memorial Site: Actual steel girders from New York City's former Twin Towers
